MUUSAN liaisons

MUUSAN members who connect with our partner organizations
Bring information back to the MUUSAN Board

Members of the Board

Work with liaisons to select bills for membership-wide advocacy

MUUSAN administrator

Maintains email lists of individual MUUSAN members who participate
in our Take Action! Google Groups
Works with Board to compose updates and send them out.

Congregational Legislative Liaisons (CLLs),

Members of MUUSAN who communicate updates to their
congregations.

Individual MUUSAN members

Take the initiative on their own, or with others in their congregations,
to advocate in a variety of ways:

- *calls/emails to legislators,
- *host postcard-writing events after church
- *write Letters to the Editor
- *write testimonies to be sent or delivered in person to committee hearings
- *provide opportunities for members to learn more about a given issue
